2026 Kosciusko County Reserve Academy

The Kosciusko County Sheriff's Department will be hosting its 2026 Reserve Academy starting in January. This year's Reserve Academy will consist of approximately 208 training hours covering defensive tactics, firearms, crime scenes, building search, K-9, STOPS and much more. The focus of the Academy is to give area Reserve Police Officers the highest level of training, taught by ILEA instructors when possible.

The 2026 Reserve Academy will run from Tuesday, January 13, 2026 to graduation on Thursday, May 21, 2026. Class will meet every Tuesday and Thursday from 6pm until 10pm, and generally every other Saturday. See the attached proposed schedule. The Academy has a maximum of 25 spots available, allowing for more efficient one-on-one instruction for students. Deadline for registration is **January 3, 2026**.

The cost of the 2026 Reserve Academy is \$250 per student. The student and/or their department will be responsible for providing 10 boxes (500 rounds) of handgun ammunition, as well as 2 boxes (50 rounds) of shotgun ammunition. (Birdshot is fine, a few slugs and/or double OO for effect would be great.) Each Department will also be responsible for providing a squad car for their officer(s) to use during the EVO Practical, STOPS classes and Field Day.
